Different types of garage doors

With these factors to bear in mind, your next step is to choose the type of garage door that suits your requirements best. At Hörmann we offer a great selection of garage doors from sectional garage doors to the classic up-&-over garage doors. Here we have highlighted the difference between each of our designs.

1) Sectional garage doors

Sectional garage doors are the popular choice for many domestic customers, as they offer the best insulation available for doors on the domestic market. They are designed to open vertically upwards and are suspended under the ceiling. This way of opening means it does not use up the space inside the garage, helping to maximise the internal space of the garage and the driveway.

<u>Sectional garage doors</u> are some of the most practical since they can be fitted in almost every garage door opening. Hörmann sectional garage doors offer flexible and weather-resistant seals on all four sides.

2) Up-and-over garage doors

The up-and-garage door is possibly the most recognisable type of garage door the world over. This is the original garage design that, at Hörmann, we have been perfecting for over 50 years.

An <u>up and over garage door</u> operates as one solid, single panel. This is lifted upwards and out and then lays flat above the opening of the garage. By choosing an up and over garage door, you will have the choice of a wide range of styles and materials. These are available as either a canopy or retractable option.

3) Roller garage doors

<u>Roller garage doors</u> are universally applicable, making this the most suitable type of garage door for smaller garage spaces and different shaped garage openings. Roller garage doors work by opening vertically, providing maximum space inside the garage as well as directly in front. The design of a roller door also means the garage ceiling is free to provide additional storage space, which is so often required by large families. The counterbalance system which is integrated into the side helps guide the operator during the opening and closing of the door and prevents damage to the operator mechanism. The multiple spring assemblies and the double lifting cables prevent the door leaf from crashing in every position. In case of emergency, the door can be easily opened by hand. A crank handle is not necessary for this purpose for roller garage doors.

4) Side sliding sectional doors

Our very own <u>side sliding sectional doors</u> have been designed as the ideal solution for those who require special fitting solutions. This door has been designed to open



to the side instead of moving upwards. This is useful for those who have limited space and wish to keep the ceiling free for storage of large, bulky items. This is also perfect for those who's garage roof is of another shape that is not flat, like a slanted or sloped roof.

5) Side hinged garage doors

For home owners with older buildings and dated garage buildings, a <u>side hinged</u> <u>garage door</u> is ideal for renovations to modernise the existing garage entrance. Typically older garages are smaller and therefore require an alternative design to modern up and over or sectional doors. A traditional side hinged door will allow the interior of the garage to be accessed via a door that opens outwards while leaving plenty of space for storage inside the garage.

6) Garage side doors

A <u>garage side door</u> is made to accompany your main garage door. These fit perfectly to the side of your garage and offer an additional access point. At Hörmann, we can provide a side door that matches perfectly with your chosen type and design of garage door.
